The dynamic process of profes sionalization in early childhood education tends to improve the performance of pedagogical work but also contributes to increasing the prestige of the profes sional field as a whole. The data on workers in German early childhood eduction is very inconsistent and for large parts not easy to use at more detailed levels. Since it was intended to provide an overview hereq various sources of data were processed and merged. As it being the best resourceq the official statistics of the German Federal Statistical Office and Regional Statistical Offices were explored and compared with existing social science-related surveys or evaluations. Remaining gaps were closed by own internet research and pencil-and-paper as well as telephone surveys.

As it turns out ${ }_{7}$ women dominate quantitatively in all segments of the sector of early childhood education. However ${ }^{\text {ed }}$ when different hierarchical levels are examined by comparison, structural gender imbalances to the detriment of women were observed whenever the position is related with increased attractiveness and responsibility.
